

(4) A TRAUMA CENTER, ON REQUEST FROM A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION, SHALL VERIFY THAT A LICENSED PHYSICIAN IS CREDENTIALLED OR OTHERWISE DESIGNATED BY THE TRAUMA CENTER TO PROVIDE TRAUMA CARE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to services rendered on or after October 1, 2001.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~June 1, 2001~~ October 1, 2001. It shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 5 of Chapter 275 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000. If that termination provision takes effect, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.

CHAPTER 424

(Senate Bill 740)

AN ACT concerning

Election Procedure Reform Act Law - Statewide Voter Registration - Provisional Ballots

FOR the purpose of altering certain procedures used by local election boards for the registration of voters who move between and within counties in the State to allow a voter's registration to follow the voter under certain circumstances; altering the required provisions to be included on in voter registration applications; providing that certain information be made available to an applicant completing voter registration applications; altering the procedures for registering applying to register to vote at the Motor Vehicle Administration; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration and the State Board of Elections jointly to establish certain procedures; altering the procedures for completing a temporary certification certificate of registration; providing for the required content of a provisional ballot; establishing certain procedures for voting by means of a provisional ballot; requiring the budget of the State Board of Elections to include funding to support any additional personnel costs associated with the provisional ballot system under certain circumstances; providing for a certain penalty for violating provisions addressing voting by provisional ballots; establishing certain procedures for canvassing provisional ballots; establishing certain appeal procedures for contested provisional ballots; authorizing the State Board of Elections to establish certain guidelines and regulations; defining a certain terms term; and generally relating to voter registrations registration and provisional ballots.
