CHAPTER 500

(House Bill 746)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County Board of Elections - Salary Increase

FOR the purpose of increasing the salaries of the president and members of the Washington County Board of Elections and the salaries of the chief election judge and other election judges of Washington County; ~~and~~ providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent president and members of the Washington County Board of Elections or the chief election judge and other election judges of Washington County; and generally relating to the salary of the members of the Washington County Board of Elections and the compensation for election judges of Washington County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

2-204.

(a) Each regular member of a local board shall receive the salary and reimbursement of expenses provided in the county budget, but in no event may the annual compensation be less than the following amounts:

(22) In Washington County, ~~[\$2,600]~~ \$5,000 for the president and ~~[\$2,300]~~ \$4,500 for other regular members;

(b) (6) (i) In Washington County, the compensation for each election day actually served shall be:

1. ~~[\$100]~~ \$125 per day for each chief election judge, plus a mileage allowance as determined by the Washington County Board; and

2. ~~[\$80]~~ \$100 per day for every other election judge.
