

(1) **[cover] COVER** any of the characters of a vehicle's registration plate;
OR

(2) **DISTORT A RECORDED IMAGE OF ANY OF THE CHARACTERS OF A VEHICLE'S REGISTRATION PLATE RECORDED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL MONITORING SYSTEM UNDER § 21-202.1 OF THIS TITLE.**

(b) A person may not sell or offer for sale a registration plate cover.

(c) A person may not advertise for the purpose of promoting the sale of registration plate covers.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 502

(House Bill 800)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Tax Sales - Notice

FOR the purpose of adding a requirement for the collector of property tax in Baltimore City to publish, at certain times, and certain places, notice of a tax sale of property at public auction; and generally relating to notice of a tax sale in Baltimore City of property at public auction.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Tax - Property

14-813.

(a) (1) At any time after 30 days from the mailing of the statement and notice, the collector shall cause to be published, 4 times, once a week for 4 successive weeks in 1 or more newspapers, that have a general circulation in the county in which the property is located, a notice that the property will, on the date and at the place named in the notice, be sold at public auction.

(2) In Frederick County, Garrett County, Kent County, and Queen Anne's County, the notice shall be published 3 times, once a week for 3 successive weeks.
