SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

4-401.

Except as provided in § 4-402 of this subtitle, and subject to the venue provisions of Title 6 of this article, the District Court has exclusive original civil jurisdiction in:

(10) A proceeding for adjudication of:

(iv) A WSSC infraction as defined in Article 29, § 18-104.2 of the Code, concerning WSSC regulations governing:

- 1. Erosion and sediment control for utility construction;
- [and]
- 2. Plumbing, gas fitting, and sewer cleaning; AND
- 3. REQUIRED PERMITS FOR UTILITY CONSTRUCTION;

Article 29 – Washington Suburban Sanitary District

18-104.2.

(a) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(1) "Enforcement official" means an employee of WSSC authorized by WSSC to issue a citation for a WSSC infraction under this section.

(2) "Regulations" means the regulations of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission governing:

- (i) Erosion and sediment control for utility construction in Prince George's and Montgomery counties;
- (ii) Plumbing, gas fitting, and sewer cleaning in the Washington Suburban Sanitary District; or
- (iii) Required permits for public utility construction in the sanitary district.
