(House Bill 336)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education - Tuition Waiver - Faculty and Employees

FOR the purpose of ~~requiring a public senior higher education institution to waive tuition for certain persons who attend the institution; repealing a provision authorizing requiring a governing board of an institution~~ *the governing boards of certain institutions* of higher education to develop a policy for the waiver of tuition ~~and room and board~~ for certain persons; *authorizing the governing boards of certain institutions of higher education to develop a policy for the waiver of room and board for certain persons;* making a stylistic change; ~~requiring certain governing boards to adopt certain provisions in tuition waiver policies for certain persons with certain limitations;~~ and generally relating to the waiver of tuition for certain persons who attend certain institutions of higher education.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

15-106.

~~(A) EACH PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION IN THE STATE SHALL WAIVE TUITION FOR A PERSON WHO ATTENDS THE PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION AND WHO IS:~~

~~(1) A FACULTY MEMBER OR AN EMPLOYEE OF ANY PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION IN THE STATE; OR~~

~~(2) A CHILD OF A FACULTY MEMBER OR EMPLOYEE OF ANY PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION IN THE STATE.~~

~~(B)~~ (1) Each governing board ~~may~~ **SHALL** develop a policy for the waiver of [tuition, and] **MAY DEVELOP A POLICY FOR THE WAIVER OF** room and board, for faculty and employees of public institutions of higher education and their children who attend public institutions of higher education in [this] THE State.

~~(2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAY DEVELOP A POLICY FOR THE WAIVER OF TUITION FOR FACULTY AND~~
