SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

[1.

Any person who shall, for purposes of prostitution, fornication or concubinage, forcibly abduct from his or her home or usual place of abode or from the custody and control of his or her parent or parents or guardian any individual under the age of 16, or be accessory thereto, or who shall for said purpose persuade or entice from his or her usual place of abode, or from the custody and control of his or her parent or parents or guardian, any such individual, or be accessory thereto, or shall knowingly secrete or harbor any such individual so abducted, persuaded or enticed as aforesaid, against the consent of his or her parent or parents or guardian, or the person or persons who may have the temporary care, custody or control of such individual, or be accessory thereto, upon conviction, is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall undergo imprisonment, in the discretion of the court, not exceeding the term of eight years. Nothing contained in this section shall apply to cases pending nor to violations of the law which have heretofore occurred, but all such cases and violations shall be prosecuted as if the law hereby repealed were still in force.]
