~~(D)~~ (E) THE JUVENILE JUSTICE ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION PILOT PROGRAM SHALL:

(1) PROVIDE PROGRAMS DESIGNED TO PROMOTE SELF-DISCIPLINE AND REDUCE DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR IN THE SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT;

(2) ENSURE THAT THE STUDENT CONTINUES TO RECEIVE APPROPRIATE EDUCATIONAL AND RELATED SERVICES DURING THE TERM OF THE SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION; AND

(3) OFFER SERVICES TO FACILITATE THE STUDENT'S TRANSITION BACK TO THE SCHOOL AFTER COMPLETION OF THE TERM OF SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before August 1 of each year, the State Board of Education shall report to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly on the implementation of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October July 1, 2001, contingent on the Governor including funding for the Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Pilot Program in the Supplemental budget for fiscal year 2002, and if funding is not provided this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.~~ It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of ~~September~~ June 30, 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
