

**Chapter 230 of the Acts of 1999**

**SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:**

[(5) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its interest:

- (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- and
- (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.

(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.]

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

**CHAPTER 65**

**(House Bill 318)**

AN ACT concerning

**State Board of Occupational Therapy Practice – Supervision of Aides**

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Occupational Therapy Practice to enable a licensed occupational therapy assistant to supervise an unlicensed aide under certain circumstances; altering the definition of a certain term; and generally relating to the supervision of aides in the practice of occupational therapy or limited occupational therapy.
