RESOLUTION NO. 1021

A RESOLUTION of the Council of the City of Salisbury proposing the annexation to the City of Salisbury of a certain area of land situate contiguous to and binding upon the Easterly corporate limits of the City of Salisbury, to be known as the "Merritt Mill Road – Moore Property Annexation" being an area located on the Southerly side of Merritt Mill Road.
