AN ORDINANCE concerning:

**Public Ethics**

FOR the purpose of amending revising the Public Ethics law; establishing certain duties and powers of the Ethics Commission; providing for the issuance of advisory opinions by the Ethics Commission; providing certain procedures for complaints filed with the Ethics Commission; establishing certain provisions related to conflicts of interest; altering certain provisions related to financial disclosure; providing for enforcement of the Public Ethics Law; defining certain terms; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the Public Ethics Law.
