


Know all men by these presents, that I John Newton of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, for and in Consideration of the sum of Three hundred and seventy five dollars Current money to me in hand paid by William Rea of the same County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said John Newton do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said William Rea, his executors, administrators and assigns my negro boy George, who was born on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of December eighteen hundred and thirty nine, being of the age of thirteen years, next December until he attains the age of forty four years after which I do hereby declare the said negro boy George from thenceforth free manumitted and discharged from all manner of service or servitude to me, my executors or administrators forever, To have and to hold the said negro boy George for the term of thirty one years from the 28<sup>th</sup> of December next as aforesaid as above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended so to be to the said William Rea his executors administrators and assigns forever; and I John Newton for myself my heirs, executors and administrators the said negro boy George for the term aforesaid unto the said William Rea his executors administrators and assigns against me the said John Newton my executors administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents

In testimony whereof the said John Newton seller and William Rea purchaser have hant set their hands and affixed their seals this fifth day of August eighteen hundred and fifty two
