THE CIVIL ENGINEERS shall direct and manage all such public works under the immediate control of [said] THE county [commissioners, and who] COMMISSIONERS. THE CIVIL ENGINEERS shall hold office for [such] THE time, with [such] THE salary, under [such] A bond and subject to [such] regulations as may be directed by the [said] county commissioners [from time to time], and calculated to secure competent officers and a faithful discharge of duty.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 20

(House Bill 571)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County – Length of Service Award Program

FOR the purpose of altering the amount of the monthly benefit under the Calvert County program of awards for length of service for certain volunteer fire and rescue personnel; ~~altering the amount of the burial benefit~~; altering the number of credits that may be earned for certain volunteer activities; and generally relating to the Calvert County length of service award program.

 Article 5 – Public Local Laws of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 5 – Calvert County

14-102.

(a) Any individual who has served as a member of any Calvert County volunteer fire company or Calvert County volunteer rescue squad is eligible to receive the following benefits, provided that:

(1) The individual is certified in accordance with the provisions of § 14-101 of this subtitle to have served as an active volunteer subsequent to January 1, 1986.
