**CHAPTER 238**  
**(House Bill 975)**

AN ACT concerning

**Kent County - Alcoholic Beverages Inspector and State's Attorney's Criminal Investigator - Salaries**

FOR the purpose of providing that the County Commissioners of Kent County shall set the salary of the alcoholic beverages inspector employed by the Board of License Commissioners, and of the criminal investigator employed by the State's Attorney; and making stylistic changes.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

(j) (2) The Kent County board of license commissioners:

(i) Shall employ one full-time alcoholic beverages inspector [and set the inspector's compensation at not less than \$8,750 nor more than \$15,000 annually] **WHOSE SALARY SHALL BE SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS;** and
