

Amendment No. 11:

On page 104, in line 18, strike the numerals “8,125,562” and substitute the numerals “7,170,106”; and in line 19, strike the numerals “67,206,313” and substitute the numerals “66,250,857”.

Amendment No. 12:

On page 105, in line 6, strike the numerals “21,642,069” and substitute the numerals “22,597,525”; and in line 7, strike the numerals “21,707,069” and substitute the numerals “22,662,525” and in line 22, strike the numerals “209,340,830” and substitute the numerals “210,296,286” and in line 23, strike the numerals “18,725,742” and substitute the numerals “16,065,331” and in line 24, strike the numerals “917,633” and substitute the numerals “2,662,588”.
