8-640. LOSS OF FEDERAL CERTIFICATION.

IN ANY YEAR IN WHICH THIS TITLE IS NOT CERTIFIED BY THE UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF LABOR UNDER § 3304 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, THE SECRETARY SHALL REFUND MONEY THAT WAS COLLECTED FROM AN INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE UNITED STATES FOR WHICH CONGRESS PERMITS EMPLOYMENT TO BE COVERED EMPLOYMENT. THE REFUND SHALL BE MADE IN THE SAME MANNER AND WITHIN THE SAME TIME PERIOD AS PROVIDED UNDER § 8-638 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SUBTITLE 7. RECIPROCAL ARRANGEMENTS.

8-701. ARRANGEMENTS TO COVER EMPLOYMENT FOR SINGLE EMPLOYING UNIT.

(A) AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO ARRANGEMENTS.

SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY MAY ENTER INTO A RECIPROCAL ARRANGEMENT WITH AN AGENCY OF ANOTHER STATE OR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT THAT IS AUTHORIZED TO DO SO.

(B) CONDITIONS OF ARRANGEMENTS.

UNDER A RECIPROCAL ARRANGEMENT THAT THE SECRETARY ENTERS INTO UNDER THIS SECTION:

(1) SERVICES THAT AN INDIVIDUAL PERFORMS FOR A SINGLE EMPLOYING UNIT FOR WHICH SERVICES USUALLY ARE PERFORMED IN MORE THAN 1 STATE ARE CONSIDERED TO BE PERFORMED ENTIRELY WITHIN:
