

7-502. TERMINATION OF TITLE.

SUBJECT TO THE EVALUATION AND REESTABLISHMENT PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND PROGRAM EVALUATION ACT, THIS TITLE AND ALL REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE SHALL TERMINATE ON JULY 1, 2002.

TITLE 8. HOME IMPROVEMENT.

SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS; GENERAL PROVISIONS.

8-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language substituted for former Art. 56, § 249(a) and revised as standard introductory language to a definition section.

(B) COMMISSION.

"COMMISSION" MEANS THE MARYLAND HOME IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly was Art. 56, § 249(i).

No changes are made.

(C) CONTRACTOR.

"CONTRACTOR" MEANS A PERSON, OTHER THAN AN EMPLOYEE OF AN OWNER, WHO PERFORMS OR OFFERS OR AGREES TO PERFORM A HOME IMPROVEMENT FOR AN OWNER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 249(e).

The former phrase "whether or not such person is licensed or subject to the licensing requirements of this subtitle" is deleted as unnecessary because it did not limit the application of the term "contractor".
