

CHAPTER 433

(House Bill 5)

AN ACT concerning

Health Occupations – Boards

FOR the purpose of authorizing the removal of members of certain health occupations boards under certain circumstances; providing certain procedures for filling vacancies on certain health occupations boards; providing that the duties of officers of certain health occupations boards shall be determined by those boards; repealing the provision prohibiting consumer members from participating in certain examination activities of the Board; altering a certain provision prohibiting consumer members from participating in certain examination activities of a certain Board; and generally relating to health occupations boards.
