

(1) Pay to the clerk of the circuit court for the county where the place of business or vending machine is located an application fee of [\$25]:

(I) \$25 IN A COUNTY OTHER THAN CECIL COUNTY; OR

(II) \$50 IN CECIL COUNTY; and

(2) Submit to the clerk of the circuit court for the county where the place of business is located an application for each place of business or vending machine.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Business Regulation**

16-204.

(b) (1) An applicant for a license to act as a retailer shall:

(i) obtain the county license required under § 16-301 of this title;

(ii) Submit to the clerk an application for each permanent or temporary place of business located in the same enclosure and operated by the same applicant; and

(iii) pay to the clerk an application fee of:

1. \$3 IN A COUNTY OTHER THAN CECIL COUNTY; OR

2. \$6 IN CECIL COUNTY.

(2) The application shall:

(i) be made on the form that the clerk requires; and

(ii) contain the information that the Comptroller requires.

16-302.

For each county license, an applicant shall:

(1) Submit an application to the clerk; and

(2) Pay to the clerk a license fee of:

(I) \$25 IN A COUNTY OTHER THAN CECIL COUNTY; OR

(II) \$50 IN CECIL COUNTY.

17-504.

An applicant for a billiard table license shall pay to the clerk a license fee of:

(1) \$10 for each billiard table in a county other than Baltimore City OR CECIL COUNTY; [or]
