

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

21.

(h) (3) On Sunday, [in addition to the on-sale license privilege,] a licensee may sell only beer and light wine for off-premises consumption.

85.

(a) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class A beer, wine and liquor license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, on every day except Sunday. [Provided, that (1) in]

(2) THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) ARE SUPERSEDED AS FOLLOWS:

(I) IN Annapolis the hours may be fixed by the Mayor, Counselor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, [(2) in]

(II) IN Talbot County the hours shall be from 8 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, [(3) in]

(III) IN St. Mary's County holders of a Class A-1 license shall be entitled to sell on Sunday, [and (4) in]

(IV) IN Frederick County holders of a Class A beer, wine and liquor (off-sale) license may sell beer, wine and liquor for off-premises consumption on Sundays from 1 p.m. to 12 o'clock midnight if they hold a special Sunday opening permit; AND

(V) IN KENT COUNTY THE PROVISIONS OF § 101 APPLY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

(House Bill 766)

AN ACT concerning

Authorized Investments – Trust Companies

FOR the purpose of authorizing trust companies in their fiduciary capacity to deposit in the trust company or in a financial institution ~~affiliated with~~ that is an affiliate of the trust company certain funds under certain circumstances; authorizing trust
