OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND ENLARGING THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF BOWIE BY ANNEXING LAND CONTIGUOUS AND ADJOINING THE EXISTING CORPORATE AREA OF THE CITY OF BOWIE CONSISTING OF APPROXIMATELY 46.6 ACRES, LOCATED SOUTH OF ELEVENTH STREET AND HUNTINGTON SOUTH PARK (AND INCLUDING A PORTION OF THE PARK) AND APPROXIMATELY 1700 FEET EAST OF CHESTNUT AVENUE, MORE COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE HUNTINGTON CREST SUBDIVISION, SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN A CERTAIN ANNEXATION AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOWIE AND THE ROLLING HILLS GENERAL PARTNERSHIP AND THE HUNTINGTON CREST HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION.
