**“An Act to Repeal the Cresaptown Fire and Ambulance Taxing District and to Establish a Cresaptown Fire Area, a Rawlings Fire Area, and a Cresaptown Ambulance Area.”**

An Act to repeal Chapter 73, Article 3, Section 73-10 thru 73-16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Allegany County (1983 Edition as amended) entitled “Cresaptown Fire-Ambulance Special Taxing Area” and enacting a new Article 5, Article 6, and Article 7 to Chapter 42.

[Erroneous codification: The County Commissioners will renumber Chapter 42, new Articles 5, 6, and 7 as Chapter 42, as 6, 7, and 8, respectively.

**“Allegany County Transfer Tax”**

An Act to impose a Transfer Tax on instruments of writing conveying title to Real Property offered for record and recorded in Allegany County with the Clerk of the Circuit Court under the authority of Article 13, Subtitle 4 of the Tax - Property Volume of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and Article 25B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1957.
