 lars current money to be paid to the said
 state of Maryland, to the which payment
 well and truly to be made and done we
 bind ourselves and each of us our and each of
 our heirs executors and administrators,
 jointly and severally firmly by these pres-
 ents sealed with our seals and dated this
 eighteenth day of September in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and fifty five. The condition of the above ob-
 ligation is such that if the above bound
 William H. Worthington as Clerk of the Cir-
 cuit Court for Howard County, shall faith-
 fully perform the duties imposed upon him
 as Clerk as aforesaid by the provisions of the
 act of the general assembly of Maryland,
 passed at December session eighteen hun-
 dred and forty four, Chapter two hun-
 dred and eighty entitled "An act im-
 posing duties on promissory notes bills
 of exchange specialties and other instru-
 ments of writing to aid in paying the debts
 of the state" and shall pay into the Treasury of
 the state of Maryland, all sums of money which
 he may receive by virtue thereof, at the peri-
 od limited in and by the said act of Assembly,
 for that purpose then the above obligation to
 be void and of none effect otherwise to be
 and remain in full force and virtue in
 law.
