 and dated this Eleventh day of April in the year of our  
 Lord One thousand eight hundred and Seventy

Now the Condition of the above obligation is Such that  
 if the above bound Thomas Burgefs Shall well and faith  
 fully execute this office as collector of the State taxes  
 and Shall will and truly account for and pay over to the  
 Treasurer of the State of Maryland the Several Sums of  
 Money which he Shall receive or be chargeable with or  
 answerable for at Such times as the Law directs then  
 this obligation to be void otherwise to be and remain in  
 full force and virtue
