Henry S. Davis } County State of Maryland for and
in consideration of the sum of
four hundred dollars lawfull money of the
United States, in hand paid by Henry S. Davis
of Howard County State aforesaid which is in
full payment of a Negro Woman named Thena
now supposed to be about 19 years of age of black col-
our to serve as a slave until the first day of
May Eighteen hundred and sixty eight (1868) and
no longer and than to be free from all manner
of servitude as will more fully appear by
reference to a Bill of Sale from J. S. Waters to Jo-
seph Pearson on Record in the office of the
Clerk of the the Court of Anne Arundle
County at Annapolis City, Maryland also a
Bill of Sale from Joseph W. Eason to Isaac
