In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirteenth day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty five, and the said John F. Jacobs have put the said William Domes of Pason in full possession by delivering me a chain in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained & sold or meant to be intended as to be
