

Naamah aged 56 years, one mule, 1 Bay Horse aged 20 years 7 horses 9 cattle and 30 head of hogs together with their increase, also the whole of my house hold and kitchen furniture and farming implements of every kind to have and to hold the same unto the said Ann Nichols for ever provided and there upon are upon these conditions that if the said James Lanimore shall die and truly pay unto the said Ann Nichols her executors administrators or assigns the said sum of eight hundred dollars with interest thereon then and in that case the same shall be void, else to remain in full force and effect.

The same being that which was granted bargained and sold to me by Thomas N. Stockell by deed of bargain and sale dated the twenty ninth day of April in the year eighteen hundred & forty one and recorded in Liber folio one of the former record books of Ann Arundel County reference thereto being had will more fully appear. To Have and To Hold the same unto the said Wm. H. Thumbert his executors administrators and assigns forever.
