To all whom it may concern, Be it
 known that I John C. Macubin of Anne Arundel
 County in the State of Maryland for divers good
 causes and considerations and the more moving as
 also in further consideration of four hundred dollars
 current money to me in hand paid have released
 from Slavery liberated manumitted and set free
 and by these presents do hereby release from
 Slavery liberated manumitted and set free my Negro
 man named Ned Galloway being of the age of
 thirty nine years and able to work and gain sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance and him the said
 Negro man named Ned Galloway I do declare
 to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged
 from all manner of servitude or service to me
 my Executors or administrators forever. In Testimony

 my seal this Eleventh day of September in the
