satisfied by the Evidence of Henrietta M. Grazier and
Colo Wm Richardson of Caroline County that the said negro man
to whom this certificate is delivered is the person mentioned
in the manumission afo. I do therefore grant his said appli-
-cation and hereby Certify that he is five feet five inches
high or thereabout Has a scar on the top of his right foot
and a small scar about the middle of his forehead and
no other particular marks that I have discovered
