

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegate.

Mr. Jones from the committee on corporations and joint stock companies, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate a company to supply the Town of Frostburg in Allegany county, with an abundant supply of water, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

In the last line of the 10th section, after the word 'road' insert 'or with the construction of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road.'

The bill was being read the second time, when

It was further amended as follows:

In the 1st line of the 13th section, after the word 'corporation' insert 'to issue any note in the nature of a bank note, nor.'

The bill was then read through.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of James Polk, register of wills of Somerset county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Cottman, Purnell and Goldsborough.

Mr. Tidball from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act to unite the fifth and sixth Congressional districts into one district,

Which was read the first and by special order the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
