

from the first of february One thowsand six hundred Sixty & sixe till the first of february One thousand six hundred sixty seaven in Compliance with the said act of our Assembly And whereas aswell the said S<sup>r</sup> William Berkely and the assembly in Virg<sup>a</sup> As the s<sup>d</sup> William Drumond & the Assembly in Carolina have passed their severall & Respective acts prohibiting the Sowing Setting planting or any waies tending any tobacco in the yeare afores<sup>d</sup> w<sup>th</sup>in their seu<sup>r</sup>all & respective Jurisdiccōns by the Advice & Consent of the Councell I doe hereby Publish the said Act & strictly charge & Comand all persons w<sup>th</sup>in this province to obserue the same vnder paine of Imprisonm<sup>t</sup> fine & such other punishm<sup>ts</sup> as by lawe may be inflicted vpon Contemners of his Lo<sup>ps</sup> lawes & lawefull comand & breakers of the Publiq ffaith and I doe hereby Strictly charge and comand all Majestrates sheriffes Constables & other his lo<sup>ps</sup> Officers to see the said Act & this Proclamacōn put in full & Effectuall execucōn Given att S<sup>t</sup> Maries vnder the greate seale of our s<sup>d</sup> Province this seaventeenth day of October in the five & thirtyeth yeare of his lo<sup>ps</sup> Dominion over this province Annoq D<sup>m</sup> One thousand six hundred sixty & Sixe

Further Articles of agreem<sup>t</sup> had made, concluded and agreed on at S<sup>t</sup> Maries in Maryland between us the Subscribed Com<sup>rs</sup> for Virg<sup>a</sup> and Maryland sufficiently impowred to Treat and conclude of a Totall Cessation of Planting Setting or soweing any Tobacco in each Colony as also in Albemarle County in Carolina as followeth.

Viz<sup>t</sup> Whereas there was an agreem<sup>t</sup> made & concluded on between the Com<sup>rs</sup> of Virg<sup>a</sup> Maryland & Albemarle County in Carolina bearing date the twelfth of July one thousand six hundred sixty six at James Citty grounded upon the severall & respective Acts of Assembly for a cessation by w<sup>ch</sup> it was assented to & concluded on that there should be a Totall Cessation from Sowing, Setting Planting or any waies tending any Tobacco in any or any part of the three Colonies afores<sup>d</sup> from the first of February one thousand six hundred sixty six untill the first of February one thousand six hundred sixty seaven. Provided W<sup>m</sup> Drumond Esq<sup>r</sup> Gov<sup>r</sup> of Albemarle County in Carolina & the Assembly of that Province did make the like Act in th<sup>t</sup> Colony. And the same should Transmitt to the Gov<sup>rs</sup> of Virginia & Maryland by the last of September then next to ensue as by the said Articles, (Relacōn being thereto had) more fully may appear. And whereas the s<sup>d</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Drummond Esq<sup>r</sup> & the Assembly of Albemarle County aforesaid did make an Act prohibiting the sowing setting, planting
