H. point att Randall Revells in Somersett County And I w<sup>th</sup> the advice of the said Councill Doe hereby further Ordaine & Declare That noe Masters of shippes boates & other vessells w<sup>soeu</sup>r coming hither for m<sup>r</sup>chandizing or trade & all other m<sup>r</sup>ch<sup>ts</sup> or other p<sup>sons</sup> w<sup>soeu</sup>r th<sup>t</sup> shall bring in to this p<sup>vince</sup> any goods or m<sup>r</sup>chandizes w<sup>soeu</sup>r to sell Barter for or trade with any the inhabit<sup>ts</sup> within this p<sup>vince</sup> shall from & after the twentyeth day of Aug<sup>t</sup> next Discharge or vnlade any goods or m<sup>r</sup>chandices w<sup>soeu</sup>r or th<sup>m</sup> sell or expose to sale at any other port Harbo<sup>r</sup> creeke or att any other place or places w<sup>th</sup>in this p<sup>vince</sup> Save only at the s<sup>d</sup> seu<sup>r</sup>all & respectiue place or places above in this Ordinance & Declaracon menconed & expressed vpon the penalty of suffering one whole yeares Imprison<sup>t</sup> without bayle or Maynprize any law vsage or custome to the contrary notw<sup>th</sup>standing & if any M<sup>r</sup> of shippes boates or other vessells m<sup>r</sup>ch<sup>t</sup> or other p<sup>son</sup> or p<sup>sons</sup> w<sup>soeu</sup>r shall sell to any Inhabit<sup>t</sup> of this p<sup>vince</sup> any goods or m<sup>r</sup>chandizes w<sup>soeu</sup>r otherwise then in this Ordinance or Declaracon is expressed th<sup>t</sup> the inhabitant or inhabi<sup>mts</sup> soe buying the same may at his or their Ellecon refuse or Deny paym<sup>t</sup> for the same & the p<sup>tye</sup> so selling the same shall not have ag<sup>t</sup> the buyer any acc<sup>on</sup> of Debt Acco<sup>t</sup> Trespas vpon the case or any other acc<sup>on</sup> w<sup>soeuer</sup> in any of his lo<sup>ps</sup> Court w<sup>soeu</sup>r w<sup>th</sup>in this p<sup>vince</sup> but shalbe uttly bard therefrom And all and every other person and persons whatsoever are hereby strictly required and commanded to Yeild their due Obedience vnto this Ordinance Edict and Declaracon as they will avoyd the paines herein expressed menconed and Declared Given vnder the Greate Seale of the said Province of Maryland this fifth day of June in the six and thirtyeth yeare of the Dominion of Ceecilius &c over the said Province annoq domini One thousand six hundred sixty Eight
