With these our instructions you will receive our Commission under our Great Seal of England constituting you our Captain Generall and Governor in Chief in and over our Province and Territory of Maryland in America, where being arrived you are forthwith to call together the Members of our Councill for that our Province and Territory By name, Sir Thomas Lawrence Knt. and bart. Henry Jowles, Nehemiah Blakiston, Nicholas Greenbury, Charles Hutchins, Charles Robotham, David Browne, Thomas Tench, Iohn Addison, Iohn Coates Iames Frizby and Thomas Brooks Eqre. At which meeting after having published in usuall manner our said commission constituting you our Captain Generall and Governor in Chief of our said Province and Territory, you shall take yourself and also administer unto Each of the members of our said Councill as well the Oaths appointed by Act of Parliament to be taken instead of the Oaths of Allegiance and supremacy
