- Page 4, line 19. "Samuel Adams," a mistake of the clerk for "Samuel Handy."
- Page 66, line 18. "W. Sprigg Wootton" should be "Th. Sprigg Wootton."
- Page 127, line 32. "Galton" should be "Dalton."
- Page 161, line 21. Letter torn.
- Page 162, line 10. Numbers duplicated in original.
- Page 172, line 13. "Nassonbaugh" for "Massenbach."
- Page 183, line 36. "Twener" for "Turner."
- Page 189, line 41. "D. G." for "Sir G."
- Page 197, line 41. "muarying," *sic.* Qy., "managing."
- Page 201, line 36. Letter not in original letter-book.
- Page 218, line 1. No doubt No. 44, but not in letter-book.
- Page 251, line 15. "proved," *sic.* Perhaps "provided."
- Page 252, line 30. "Jon^a" for "Jos^a".
