By the house of Burgesses July the 2nd 1696.

This house humbly represent to yo' Excy that there are at this tyme one white serv' woman and two Indians in the Custody of the Sherriff of Ann Arundel County for Murther or suspition thereof.

Therefore we humbly Supplicate your Exc^{1y} that you would be so favorably pleased to take such measures therein as your Ex^{cy} shall in your Wisdome think fitt to [Exonerate the County] from such charges as may arise from long detey[ning them in Custody]

Sent p M^r Jenkins, and M^r Scarborough.—[and who are ordered] to acquaint his Ex^{cy} that this house desire [his Ex^{cy} to send] downe some of his Ma^{tys} hon^{ble} Councill to administer the oaths appointed by act of parliament to M^r George Ashman, elected a Burgess for Baltemore County.

Capt Tasker, Mr Crauford and Mr Dixon enter the house.

The honble Col: George Robotham and Col Charles Hutchins came downe from his Ex^{cy} and administered the Oaths appointed by act of parliament unto the afd. Mr Ashman who Subscribed the test.

Also the said Gentⁿ of his Ma^{tys} hon^{ble} Councill brought the following proposalls from his Ex^{cy} upon which the house debated and resolved on as followeth, Imp^{rs} That all the Indian Land be adjusted and the bounds ascertayned Referr'd to the Consideration of the next Assembly for a Law to be made for ascertaining thereof.

2^d That all Ma^{rs} of Shipps for the future coming in give an acc^t to the Collectors and Navall officers upon Oath what Lres they bring in with them as also of what goods are consigned to any persons. Assented to by the house.

3d What to be done with the Shipps left behinde in the

Country.
