May 17th 1701.

On behalfe of his most sacred Maj^{ty} King William the third by the Grace of God of England, Scotland, ffrance and Ireland &c:

I will these to be Laws.

Which being done his Excellency was pleased to Seale the same with the Broad Seale of this province which Lawes being soe signed and sealed his Ex^{cy} was pleased to acquaint this house that he thought it Convenient for his Majestys service to Prorogue them untill the first day of Iuly next and that they were thereby accordingly prorogued.
