And Ordered that M<sup>r</sup> John Hall and M<sup>r</sup> John Wight Attend his Ex<sup>cy</sup> in Councill to see him quallified

They returne and say they have seen him Sworne and Signe the Test.

M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Frisby A Member Elected to serve for Cæcill County being prsent in the house and returnd by Com<sup>ee</sup> to be duely Elected but not of age w<sup>ch</sup> now lye under debate

M<sup>r</sup> Speaker being pleased to enquire into his Age the s<sup>d</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Frisby readily acknowledged himselfe not to be of full age till December next

Whereupon it is Resolved that he is not quallified nor fitt to sitt in this house

Therefore he is dismiss and Ordered M<sup>r</sup> Speaker Issue his Warrant to the honoble Secretary to send forth A new Writt to Serve in his Stead which Accordingly issued
