The within peticon and the Councill's Resolve thereupon
was here read and by this house resolved they concurr there-
with and grant'd that the Pet^r have and enjoy such lott or Acre
of land to be taken up and built upon to him and his heires
for ever as fully and Amply as any p^rsons whatsoever that
built in the Towne pursuant to the Act of Assembly
