upon the reporte of those Indians now Ioyning the Senecas in P. R. O. order to warr with the Insharora's both to discover their B. T. Md.

Strength and Aliances And Electrica to an extension of the control of th Strength and Aliances And likewise to provide for the better Securety of this province & that All Aliances be setled with our neighbour Indians.

- That Six County Courts in one Yeare are thought too many and therefore burthensome and cause Great County leavys whereas here being but two provintiall Courts in A Yeare the delay of Iustice is Complained of It is proposed whither it would not be of Advantage to the province and the trade thereof that in every yeare there be held four provinciall Courts two for tryalls and two for Appearances all which Courts would not Continue much longer or be of much greater charge then the two at present now are And whither the Sitting of the County Court Justices might not be better regulated by taking turns four at A time being enough to hold A Court whereas there are some times twelve at once upon the bench that the extravagancy of their Iurisdiction be reasonably limitted As to the sume And that Execution be not Stayd Untill After the tenth of May Yearly.
- That the Act of Assembly for pleading discount in barr be explaind by some public Vote or Resolve of the house being Wilfully mistaken by the Iustices in Severall County Courts by which practise its feared many perjury's are introduced.
- That Effectuall Measures be taken by this Assembly to oblidge Coopers and others setting up tobacco casq to comply with and not Exceed the Act of Assembly in the tare of those casq w<sup>ch</sup> are Greviously Complaind of by severall Masters of Shipps and destructive to trade owners and builders of Vessells not knowing how to regulate them for Stowage And by Which means Alsoe her Majis Governour is defeated of Great parte of the revenue by the Act of Assembly and her Majesty's Royall instruccons designed & Allotted him.
- 17. That the limittacon of Actions on Account is too shorte so that A Credittor cannot be civill to his Debtor for fear of that Act which is desired by severall to be Extended for one Yeare more.
- That the Act of Assembly for punishing fornication and Adultery be explaind when a mans Estate shall redeem his body.
- That All County leavys and Vestrys Accounts be yearly laid before the Governour & Councill for their inspection
- That All freemen be oblidged to give A good Account of themselves how they gaine their livelyhoods or in default of their being able to give such Accot the Iustices of the County Court be empowred to place them out to worke and
