The third Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the Town & Port of Annapolis in Ann Arundel County the fifteenth Day of May 1705 and from thence by his Excellency John Seymour Esq<sup>r</sup> Cap<sup>t</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> and Governor in Chief in & over her Majestys Province of Maryland & the Territories thereto bolonging by several Writs of Prorogations prorogued to the 17<sup>th</sup> Day of May instant and in the third Year of Her Majesty's Reign &<sup>ca</sup> Anno Dom. 1705.
