Col Young and two more from the Upper House deliver M^r Speaker the following Message Viz.

By the Upper House of Assembly June 6th 1719.

Gent.

p. 155 It is Very well known how kind and Serviceable his Excellency the Governour has been to this Province dureing his administration here, not only in the Supporting the Authority of his Lordship but in consulting the true interest of Maryland.

Wherefore we offer to your Consideration whether it be not reasonable (this being probably the last Sessions of Assembly that we shall have the happiness to meet him in) to make him some Gratefull Acknowledgment for all his favours.
