Coll^o Tilghman & Coll. Ward from the Upper House Acquaint M^r Speaker that the Lord Proprietary requires him and the rest of the Members of this House, to Attend him Immediately in the Upper House, They withdrew.

M^r Speaker with the rest of the Members of this House went to the Upper House.

The Speaker Presented to the Lord Proprietary, The following Ingrossed bills. [This list is printed at page 53.]

p. 496 All which the Lord Proprietary by the Clerk of the Council declared his Assent to.

After which his Lordship was pleased to make the following Speech. [This speech is printed at page 54.]

Then the Chancellor declared by Order of his Lordship, The Assembly be Prorogued to the first Tuesday in July next; And the Assembly is accordingly Prorogued.

M^r Speaker with the rest of the Members of this House returned.

Thereupon, this House stands Prorogued to the first Tuesday in July next
