No. 45 lays before you requires the Immediate Attendance of M^r Speaker and the whole House in the Upper House and M^r Jenings further said that to prevent mistakes they were ordered to deliver M^r Speaker a paper containing the Words aforesaid which was delivered accordingly and thereupon M^r Speaker and the whole House go to the Upper House and afterwards Return to the Lower House, where M^r Speaker Reassumed the Chair and reported to this House that his Excellency the Governor in his Speech (of which he did not deliver M^r Speaker a Copy) was pleased with the Advice of his Lordships Council of State to prorogue this present General Assembly until the first Tuesday in September next and thereupon this House stands accordingly Prorogued to that Time
