It is humbly prayed that it may be Enacted. p. 22

And be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful to and for the respective Justices of Talbot and St. Mary's Counties aforesaid, and they are hereby directed to allow unto the said Jonas Green, in their next County Levy, the Sum of fifteen Pounds Current Money, in each of the said respective Counties, over and above the usual annual Allowance to be made him for printing the Laws of this Session; any former Law to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.
