Caecilius Absolute Lord & Propriet<sup>ry</sup> of the Provinces of Mary-  
land & Avalon Lord Baltemore &c to our Trusty & welbeloved  
Cap<sup>t</sup> John Jordaine & John Warren gent<sup>l</sup> Greeting We Comand  
you that by the Oathe of Twelue good & Lawfull men of yo<sup>r</sup> County  
of S<sup>t</sup> Maryes by whom the truth of the matter may the better be  
knowne you diligently Inquire what lands & Tenem<sup>ts</sup> John Thimbleby  
late of the same County Decd held of us in his Demesne as of ffee  
att the tyme of his death, & of what Manno<sup>r</sup> & by what services, &  
how much those lands or Tenem<sup>ts</sup> are of value by the yeare in all  
Issues, & att what tyme the said John Thimbleby dyed, & who is his  
next heyre, & of what age the heyre is, & who those lands or Tenem<sup>ts</sup>  
from the tyme of the death of the said Jn<sup>o</sup> Thimbleby haue or doe  
Occupy, & y<sup>e</sup> Issues & profitts thereof haue or doe Receive, & by what  
title, & how, & in what manner, & the Inquiscoñ thereof distinctly &  
openly made to us in our Chancery under yo<sup>r</sup> hands & Seales & the  
hands & Seales of them by whom itt shalbe made without delay you  
send & this writt wittnes our selfe att our Citty of S<sup>t</sup> Maryes the 13<sup>th</sup>  
day of Aprill in the 43<sup>th</sup> yeare of our Dominion &c Annoq<sup>ue</sup> Dm 1675
