County in the Province of Maryland planter doe stand firmly bound
and indebted to Hamnah Armstrong of Boston in New England under
the seal and sole execution of Mathew Armstrong late of Boston
in New England Merchant deceased) in his full and last will and
quantity of eleven thousand pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco
and Cash to be paid in some convenient place in Massachusetts or
Manwah in Somerset County aforesaid to the said Hamnah Armstrong
his heirs executors or Assignes Attorney at or upon the last day of
October next ensuing the date hereof for his true performance use
of the said Daniell Curtis sole heirs assigns the said Hamnah Armstrong
and assigns firmly by these presents he himself witness of his said
Daniell Curtis sole heirs assigns with his hand and seal the 11th
day of January A. D. one thousand six hundred seventy one
