say itt unto his Ex^{ty} you shall not respit his Ex^{ty} debts for
any gift or fauour where you may raise him without grievance
of his Debtor; you shall truly and Rightously treat the people of
yo^r Shereshire and doe right to poore as well as to rich in all
that belongeth to your office; you shall doe no wrong to any man
for any gift or other benefite promise of goods for fauour nor shall
you shall disturbe no mans right; you shall requitt all those of
whome you shall any thing receiue of his Ex^{ty} debts you shall
nothing take whereby his Ex^{ty} may loose or that Right may be
letten or disturbed or his Ex^{ty} debts delayed; you shall truly
returne and truly serue his Ex^{ty} writts as farre forth as it shall be
in yo^r running you shall receiue no writts vnsuall nor sealed by
any but by the Justices of the Chancery Preuentiall or County Courts
or such other as shall be hereto directed by the Lord Proprietary
you shall truly sell and returne reasonable and due issues of land
that be within yo^r Baluioe after their estate and value. All
these things you shall well and truly obserue.
