8 in the Gilchrist amendment. It will be debated unless this  
9 particular motion is adopted.

13 Representation means that our roads program is  
14 decided by the delegates and senators that represent our  
15 county. Representation means the bridges or promises  
16 of bridges that seem to be present in the legislature.  
17 Representation means tax-sharing programs that are put into  
18 action in this state.

19 Representation means whether or not the  
20 capital improvement programs that we finance through our  
21 tax rate and state tax rate every year on our tax bill,
