representatives confirmed by the testimony on oath of at least two disinterested witnesses.

Forms when

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the original filled up to be blank forms or tabular statements when so filled copied in al phabetical or and attested, shall be by said Commissioners copied in alphabetical order and indexed into suitable books of record, to be procured and furnished by the said Commissioners at their own cost and expense, which books of record together with all the original papers therein copied, shall be deposited with the Clerk of the Circuit Court in each of the counties, and with the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, and shall be by them preserved among the public records of the counties and city respectively aforesaid; and said books of record and papers when so preserved shall be and they are hereby declared to be legal evidence upon all questions concerning the ownership of slaves in this State at the time of the adoption of the Constitution by which said slaves were emancipated.

Compensation for services.

And be it enacted, That the said Commissioners for the performance of the duties prescribed in this Act, shall be entitled to charge and receive the sum of twenty-five cents per capita, for each and every slave by him recorded as so formerly owned, to be paid in all cases by the former owner or owners, and no compensation or charge of any kind whatever, under the provisions of this Act shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Limited.

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That the aforesaid Commissioners shall perform the duties of their respective offices within twelve months from the date of the appointment and qualification, and that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
