

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE PEOPLE AT THE GENERAL ELECTION IN NOVEMBER, 1936 AND 1938.

Chapter 463 of the Acts of 1935.

An Act to propose an amendment to repeal Section 36 of Article 3 of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, title "Legislative Department," said section prohibiting the General Assembly from authorizing a lottery, and providing for the submission of said amendment to the qualified voters of the State of Maryland for adoption or rejection.

Chapter 426 of the Acts of 1935.

An Act to amend Section 21 of Article 4, title "Judiciary Department," sub-title "Part III—Circuit Courts" of the Constitution of this State, and to provide for the submission of said amendment to the qualified voters of this State for adoption or rejection.

Chapter 584 of the Acts of 1935.

An Act to propose an amendment to Section 13 of Article 3 of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, title "Legislative Department," providing for the appointment of persons by the Governor to fill vacancies in the House of Delegates or in the Senate of the General Assembly of Maryland and providing for the submission of said amendment to the qualified voters of the State for adoption or rejection.
