Created in 1989, the Commission to Save the Lighthouses is studying ways and means to preserve lighthouses in Maryland waters (Chapter 642, Acts of 1989). The Commission is to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and General Assembly by July 1, 1996.

The Commission is composed of sixteen members. Eleven are appointed by the Governor. As members, two senators are chosen by the Senate President and two delegates by the House Speaker. The U.S. Coast Guard also designates one member. The Department of Legislative Reference and the Maryland Historical Trust provide staff for the Commission (Code 1957, Art. 41, sec. 18-301).
